- A trained professional capable of methodically and fairly assessing student projects within the guidelines provided by our lead judges
- A sound communicator who can provide thorough feedback – both written and oral - in a constructive and positive manner to secondary students.
- Competent with technology, particularly with operating video-conferencing

As a judge, you will be working alongside scientists, teachers, environmentalists, engineers, communicators, artists and businesspeople who understand and appreciate the value of science.
